Each year thousands of young drivers nationwide lose their lives in automobile accidents. While there are numerous causes to these tragic events, a major contributing factor is the use of alcoholic beverages by teenagers.

Shattered Lives of Tomball, Inc. in conjunction with Tomball Police Department, Tomball Fire Department, Tomball High School, Concordia Lutheran High School, Tomball Regional Hospital, Northwest Emergency Medical Services, PHI Air Medical and area businesses, has decided to address the issue on a community wide basis. Shattered Lives of Tomball is being presented at Tomball and Concordia Lutheran High School on a bi-annual basis and will graphically stress the consequences of poor decision making by involving students in the creation of a fatality DWI accident simulating their own death. The program will impress upon teenagers that death is very real and that they are **NOT IMMORTAL !**

The program has been in existence in Montgomery County for several years, and based on positive feedback from the community, is making a significant impact on the lives of the teenagers and their parents. In addition to the social impact to those involved and according to available funding, Shattered Lives of Tomball, Inc. will be awarding a preset amount scholarship to one qualifying High School graduating senior and one qualifying High School junior, based on their involvement in the program.
